Ireland in 1978

- ▶ Population was 3.329 million
- ▶ Jack Lynch was Taoiseach, Patrick Hillary was President
- ▶ Cork were All Ireland Senior Hurling Champions, Kerry were Senior Football Champions
- ▶ Boomtown Rats were 2 weeks at number 1 in the UK charts with 'Rat Trap'
- ▶ Average house price was about €30,000
- ▶ There were 628 people killed and 9,313 injured in road accidents

Ireland in 1978 vs Ireland 2018

- ▶ 500,000 private cars on the road vs 2,000,000 + in 2018
- ▶ Mobile phone didn't exist vs 3,500,000 smart phone users in Ireland in 2018
- ▶ 1% of children were obese vs 10% in 2018 (20% over weight)
- ▶ RTE 1 and 2 only tv channel available to most vs 130 on Saorview, 280 on Basic Sky
- ▶ Video games introduced - limited numbers sold vs €260,000,000 market in Ireland in 2018
- ▶ Number in full time 3rd level education 37,000 vs 181,000 in 2018

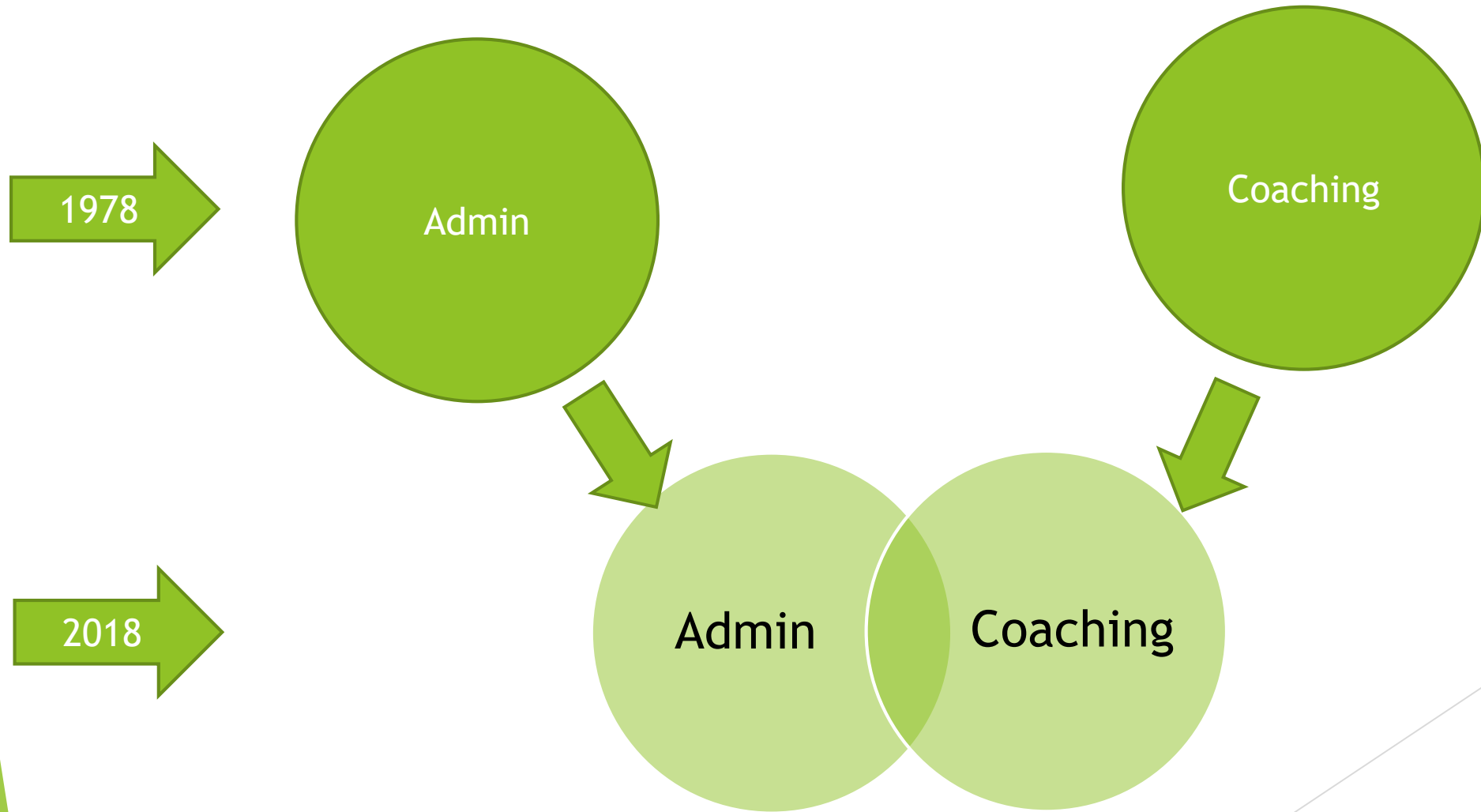

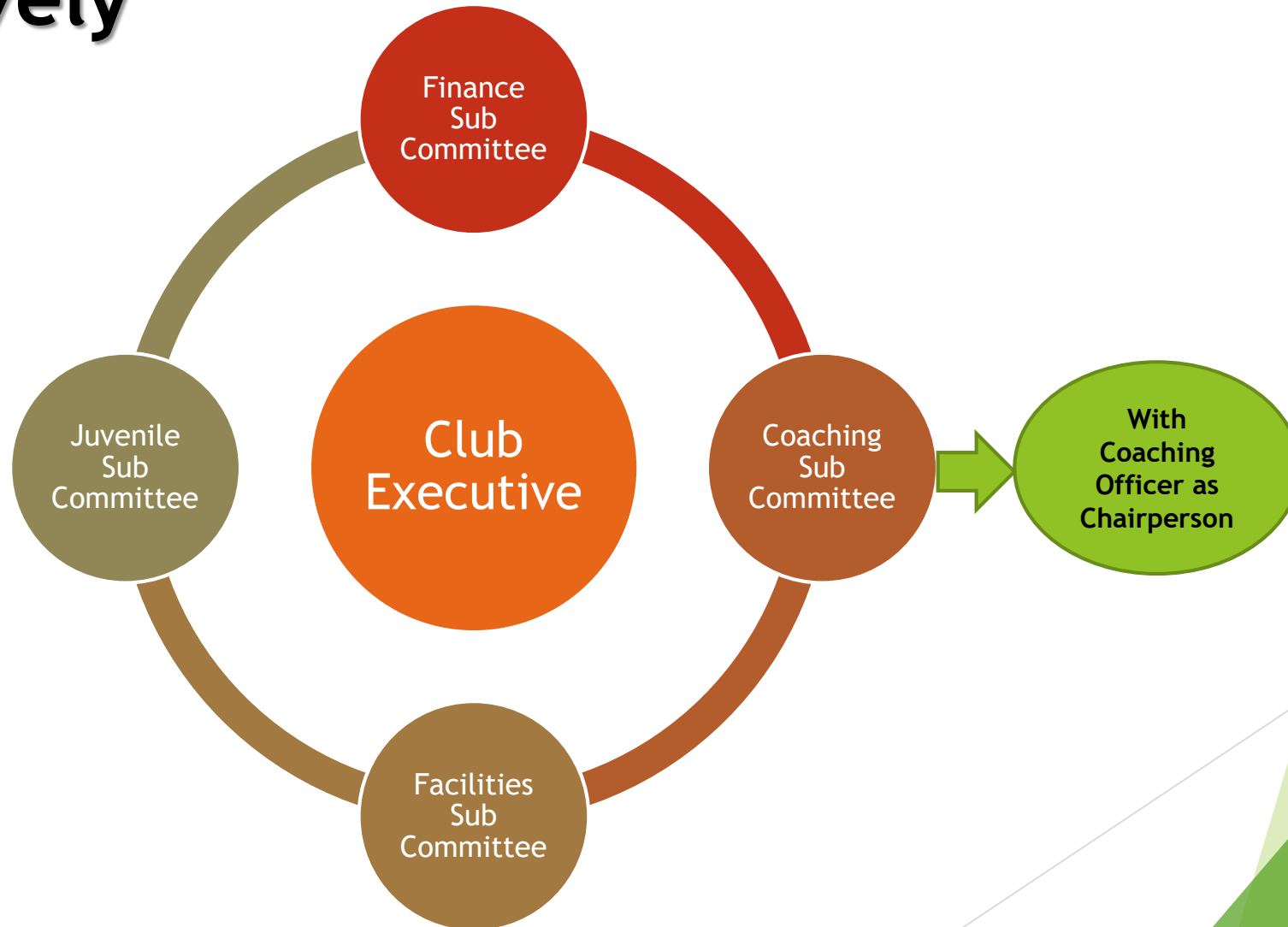
